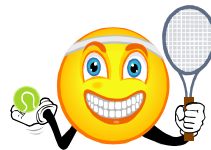


## Sport Relief - Sponsor forms

If you haven't already done so please can all sponsor forms and money be returned to school by Wednesday 24th March. We will be able to let parents know next week in the newsletter how much was raised.

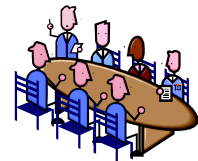
## Multi Sports Day
