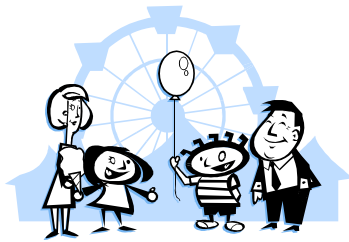

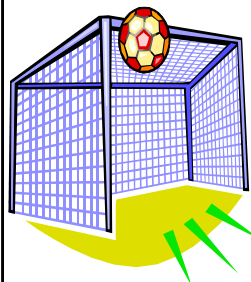


Sun Hats/Water
