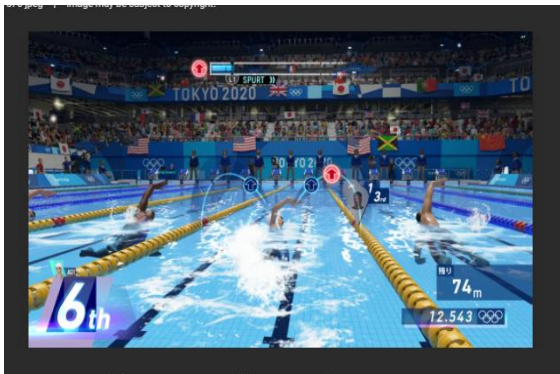


Mrs Nester's Home Learning Weekly Challenge: 20th April 2020
