

<p><u>Literacy</u> Read the story of the Three Little Pigs and make puppets of the characters. Use lolly sticks and card/ old socks etc. to make the puppets and use them to act out the story.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Practise counting in 10s. Start from 0-100 and then try starting on other numbers eg. 3, 13, 23, 33</p>	<p><u>Art</u> Choose something in nature that you really love. Look very carefully at the different shapes and colours. Try to draw these remembering to keep looking carefully. Colour it in if you like.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Have a look around one room in your house. Make a list of all the different materials you can find.</p>
<p>Ask your child questions about the story. Why did the pigs have to leave home? Why did the straw house blow down so easily? Who built the best house? Why was it better than the others? Why did the wolf get cross?</p>	<h1>Home Learning Year 2</h1>		<p><u>Science</u> Choose one of the materials you have found and describe its properties eg. Metal is smooth, shiny, cold, rigid.</p>
<p><u>Phonics</u> Look at all the different ways of spelling the ai sound - ai, ey, a, a-e etc. Make a list of words that use the different spellings.</p>	<p><u>Maths</u> <u>Internet games!</u></p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Look at a map of Street and draw on it your route to school. You could create your own map from memory marking on significant features on the way.</p>	<p><u>Computing</u> Look at a geography based app such as google maps. Explore how to find Street. How can we navigate the maps? Can children zoom in on the map? Why is this useful? What can they see?</p>

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
