

Autumn/winter observational drawings.</p>	<p>Count the number of Gingerbread men that you bake or draw. Can you give them the right amount of buttons to match the numbers 1,2,3,4,5? Practice counting sets of objects. Watch number blocks on cbeebies.</p>	<p>Make gingerbread men – name the ingredients you need. What signs of Autumn can you see outside from your window? Are there any trees or plants that have changed? What is the weather like in Autumn? Keep a weather log for the week where you can</p>	<p>Explore your five senses (this would be good to do when baking Ginger bread men). What do the different ingredients look like, feel like, taste and smell. Do any of them make a sound?</p>
