

## Mrs Nester's Home Learning Weekly Challenge: 30<sup>th</sup> March 2020



3. Can you try to make a rainbow using a bubble like mixture? While the sun is shining take some bubble mixture outside and see what you can do.



4. Can you find out some information about how rainbows are made?

5. Can you write a list of things that you might hope to find at the end of a rainbow? Rainbows are what we see at the end of a storm, we look forward to sharing a rainbow with all of you when this storm has passed and we are all together again.
