3. Find a stamp and take a walk to a local post box to send your postcard. If not and you know where your friend lives walk past and from a safe distance deliver it through the letter box. Think how delighted and surprised they will be!







4. Make your own family sky of friendship. Get a black piece of paper and if you have some star stickers great! If not just cut out some star shapes and stick them on every time you see someone in your house showing an act of friendship or kindness. See how many stars you can collect in a week. As a reward decide on a 'time in treat' for all the family which you could plan to do once we are all able to go outside.
