

## Mrs Nester's Home Learning Weekly Challenge: 8<sup>th</sup> June 2020

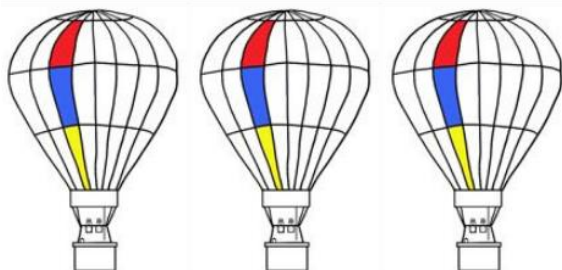
