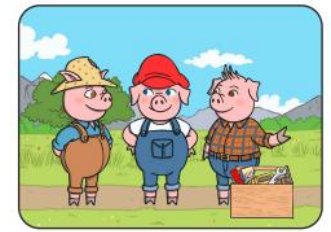


Year 1 Curriculum Map Autumn 1

English:

Our main writing focus will be learning and writing a traditional tale. We are going to be re-telling the story of The Three Little Pigs and then using our sentence writing skills to write about elements of the story.



We also make a link to Science and write factual sentences about Autumn.

Year 1 pupils would also benefit from practising their handwriting skills and learning spellings such as: *he, she, we, be, go, no, so, do.*

In Sounds-Write we will be practicing sounds we already know and learning spellings for ai/ee/oa and er/oo. Look out for how you can support this in the books red practice books children bring home.

Maths:

As mathematicians we will be focussing on Number and Place Value. and Addition and Subtraction within 10. We want the children to be secure in reading, writing and counting numbers and understanding the difference in their values. We want children to be able to compare numbers, to continue number sequences and to solve problems involving number.

In number sense activities we will practice subitising and representing amounts in different ways such as with objects, on our fingers, in a tens frame and in a part-part model.

Year 1 pupils would benefit from counting forwards and backwards in 1's starting from any given number. They could practise reading and writing numbers as words and as numerals.

Science:

As Scientists we will be thinking about our amazing bodies! We will learn the names of body parts and facial features and find out and use our senses in different ways. As the autumn comes, we will look out for signs of change in the weather and what we can see around us.

Challenge - Can you use your senses to go on an autumn walk?

Music:

In music we will be learning a song called 'Hey You' which is in an 'old school Hip-Hop' style! Children will think about the pulse, rhythm and pitch of the song through singing, moving and playing instruments. **You could listen to It's Like That by Run DMC / U Can't Touch This by MC Hammer or Me, Myself and I by De La Soul as a similar style at home. Enjoy!**

RE: The children will join assemblies based on our school and Christian values and also stories from the Bible. They will learn about the Creation Story and why we should care for our world. Children will then move on to thinking about Harvest.

Homework:

We really value the time that you spend reading with your child. Supporting them by practising sounds, words and talking about their book really makes a HUGE difference to their reading progress. Thank you!

ICT:

Our learning in ICT will involve talking about the technology that we have in our everyday lives at home and school. Children will learn about the uses and different parts and different jobs of the technology we use.

Art:

As artists we will be exploring how we can use objects and materials to create a print. We will be exploring the work of Wassily Kandinsky and using shapes to create our own piece of artwork.



History:

As Historians we shall be finding out about what our school was like a long time ago. We will use a variety of photos to compare the buildings and see if we can spot the features that have changed or the things that have stayed the same. We will also look at the old school records to find out what children in the past used to learn.

Curriculum for life:

Relationships, the people who can help us and our relationships with our friends will be the focus of our circle time conversations. We will be encouraging the children to be respectful and mindful of ideas and opinions that might be different to their own.

PE:

In PE we will be developing our fitness skills such as agility, balance and co-ordination and building stamina. We will also be zooming in on the game of Handball.
