At the end of last term we asked for feedback from our parents and carers through our parent view questionnaires. The results were compiled during the summer holidays and as always they were very positive. It is so encouraging to staff and a great motivator at the beginning of a new school year to know that our parents and carers think that the school is doing well. It is also very reassuring to new families to know that the children who have come before them have had such positive experiences during their time at Hindhayes. 100% of respondents felt that their child is happy, feels safe, makes good progress, is well looked after, is taught well and would recommend this school to other families in the local area. Almost all families felt that the pupil's here behave well and that the school responds well to concerns, provides useful information about their child's progress and is well led.

At this time we had 42% of families who don't know if the school deals effectively with bullying as their child had never been bullied and 58% felt that the school did deal effectively with these types of incidents.

Thank you once again for the time taken to help us gather this information. Over the last four years we have increased the positive perceptions of parents in all areas of our school practice.
